WENTY

TOURING SIDE

SELECTIONS

Players who wish to be considered for the Wenty squad of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club will be selected from the list of registered players of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club of the upcoming season. To be considered players must be registered by 1 March in the year of travel.

ORDER OF ENTRY

Order of entry for players will be by the method of the most continuous games played for the Aspley Rugby League Football Club, games will count only from the previous seasons. If there is an equal amount of games played by two (2) or more players to decide positions in the Wenty squad, the Committee will randomly select the players required through a draw at an official Committee meeting. The decision made regarding the eligibility of a player, by the Aspley Rugby League Football Club Committee will be final.

NUMBER OF PLAYERS

Nineteen (19) players of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club under thirteen (U/13) and under fourteen (U/14) teams of the current season will be selected to be in the Wenty squads. A total of thirty eight (38) players.

UNDER AGE PLAYERS

Any player who is playing up an age and wishes to be considered for order of entry to the Wenty squad of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club must have played up an age for the previous three (3) seasons prior to the current season to be eligible. All players are eligible to tour to Wenty once only.

INELIGIBLE PLAYERS

Any player who receives an invitation and declines that invitation in a previous year will not be considered in the current year, unless exceptional circumstances exist. They will not be considered by the Committee.

BILLETING OF PLAYERS

All players who are in the Wenty squads of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club must take an opposition player to billet at their premises, unless the Aspley Rugby League Football Club Aspley Committee decides otherwise.

TOURING

When the Aspley Rugby League Football Club is touring to and from Wentworthville, the trip will be scheduled to travel by plane. Whilst travelling to and from Wentworthville, touring teams must be accompanied by at least the team's Coaches, Managers and any other team officials.

TEAM OFFICIALS - MANAGER

Wenty Tour Managers are normally current or past managers within the current touring age group. The manager is appointed by the Aspley Rugby League Football Club Committee and this decision is final.

ASPLEY By-Laws – Continued.

TEAM OFFICIALS - COACH

Coaches for the Wenty squad are chosen on a longest serving basis for club loyalty. The coach does not need to be coaching in the age groups in the current season. The coach is appointed by the Aspley Rugby League Football Club Committee and this decision is final.

TOURING ITINERARY

Because of insurance regulations, the touring itinerary must be adhered to at all times, unless agreed upon by the Wenty Committee and allowed by the Aspley Rugby League Football Club.

LEVY

All selected players of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club Wenty squads, are required to pay to Aspley Rugby League Football Club the amount of \$100.00. The amount of \$50.00 must be received by the Aspley Rugby League Football Club before or at round four (4) of the current season. The balance of \$50.00 must be paid before June 30th of the current season. If monies not received by due date the players position in the Wenty squad will be forfeited and money refunded.

PLAYER FINANCIAL STATUS

All selected players of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club Wenty squads, are required to be financial with the Aspley Rugby League Football Club by 30 April in the current season. This means all outstanding monies for the normal season (eg sign on fees, representative fees, etc) must be fully paid. If player is not financial by due date, the players position in the Wenty squad will be forfeited and any levies paid will be refunded.

PLAYER FUNDRAISING

Each player who is a member of the Wenty squad of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club is to raise \$50.00 minimum amount from fundraising activities run by the Aspley Committee. If monies not received by Aspley Rugby League Football Club players position in the Wenty squad will be forfeited and all monies raised by said player to that point will not be refunded.

TEAM FUNDRAISING

Coaches and managers of both teams of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club comprised in the Wenty squads are to be heavily involved in fundraising activities, if not, their place in the Wenty squad will be forfeited. In this situation, the Committee of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club will appoint Club officials to the position(s).

COMMENCEMENT OF ROSTERED RAFFLES

The under thirteen (U/13) team's parents of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club will be rostered to begin fundraising raffles in the Aspley Leagues Club coinciding with the appointment of the team. The roster is managed by the Manager of the U13s squad. The parents are required to participate in the raffle until the next year's team is selected or twelve (12) months has passed.

ROSTERED RAFFLES

The parent(s) of a player(s) of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club who are in the Wenty squad are to do rostered raffles in the Aspley Leagues Club when required. If not adhered to, then position of that parent's player in the Wenty squad will be forfeited.

ASPLEY By-Laws – Continued.

COLLECTING OF MONEY

Only adult persons from the Aspley Rugby League Football Club, Wenty squad members, or the parent(s) of player(s) in the Wenty squad, are to be involved with regard to the selling of raffle tickets or the collecting of money, at all times, and with no exception.

RECEIPTS

All monies collected from raffles, fundraising, etc for the purpose of the Wenty squads of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club must be provided to the Aspley Football Office, Wentworthville Committee Members or the treasurer of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club and a receipt must be issued.

DISPUTES

Any disputed rule will be determined by and at the discretion of the Committee of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club and the ruling made by the Committee of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club will be final.

SUPPORTERS

Supporters of the Wenty Squad or the Wentworthville trip are invited to participate in the trip to Wentworthville at their cost. This cost is not subsidised by the Aspley Rugby League Football Club.

SUPPORTER – TRAVEL

Supporters may arrange their own travel, or can participate in the Group Booking organised by Aspley Rugby League Football Club. Supporters must pay a non-refundable booking deposit of \$50 before their flight will be booked. Once flights are booked, the Aspley Rugby League Football Club is unable to refund this money. The full cost of the flight must be paid for by 31 May in the year of travel. Then the full payment is made to the airlines. Supporters must take out their own insurance for flight costs as these are not refundable.

SUPPORTER – ACCOMODATION

Supporters may arrange their own accommodation or can participate in the Group arrangements organised by Aspley Rugby League Football Club. Accommodation at Wentworthville is at the Formula One Motel due to its convenient location near Wentworthville Leagues Club. Any children travelling must be supervised by an adult in the motel. The accommodation is booked by the Wenty Committee. However, cancellations must be made by 31 May in the year of travel. Full accommodation payment must be made by 30 June in the year of travel.

SUPPORTER – SATURDAY OUTING

Wentworthville may host Saturday outings. Any supporters may attend these outings at their own cost. They must notify the Wenty Committee so tickets/transport arrangements can be made. The supporter outing is for over 18 only. The theme park trip can be attended by under 18s, however they must be accompanied by an adult as it is not the responsibility of the tour officials to supervise other Aspley children.

SUPPORTER – SATURDAY DINNER

Wentworthville host a dinner on Saturday night for Aspley supporters. This dinner has no charge for Aspley supporters. The event is only for supporters over the age of 18.

GRAND FINAL TICKETS

As the Wenty trip occurs on the weekend of the Rugby League Final, Aspley Rugby League Football Club will arrange a group booking for those supporters and players wishing to attend. This is at the cost of the participants and their own travel arrangements must be made. This is not a supervised event, so only players who have a supporter attending and willing to supervise are allowed to attend. These players must also purchase a ticket for their billet. Grand Final tickets must be ordered by 1 April in the year of travel and be fully paid for by 30 June in the year of travel.

DISPUTES

Any disputed rule will be determined by and at the discretion of the Committee of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club and the ruling made by the Committee of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club will be final.

The above by laws relating to Wenty will operate from the 18 October 2008 which is the date of the motion passed by the Committee of the Aspley Rugby League Football Club to adopt these by laws.
