



## Team First Aid Officer

### **Objective**

- To provide medical treatment and advice to the Coach and players for the team allocated to his/her care.

### **Responsibilities**

- Work in accordance with the ARL Code of Conduct for the conduct of the game for players 5-18 years of age.
- Promote the importance of club members adhering to the GBJRL Positive or It's Pointless Program.
- Apply the code of conduct for staff and players that supports the objectives of the Club on and off the field.
- Maintain a current First Aid and Sports Injury certificate.
- Develop/revise code of conduct regarding injury treatment for coaching staff and players.
- Ensure adequate supplies of strapping tape and medical supplies are available in accordance with Club policy.
- Instruct the players placed under their care, in the treatment of any injury.
- Wear appropriate attire as required by the GBJRL.
- Be in attendance in the change rooms prior to the game at a time agreed upon with the team coach.
- Provide game day medical support to all players.
- Provide post game treatment of any injuries to players.
- Provide regular reports to the relevant coaches on the state of any injury to any player.
- Provide an Accident Report Form to the Football Operations and Development Manager on any injury which requires assistance during a game.

### **Relationships**

- Reports to the Coach.
- Liaises with the Coach and Development Officer & Coaches

### **Accountability**

- Accountable to the Football Operations and Development Manager.
